WHAT IT IS

LOYALS Academy is a paid, mentor-led work experience programme that gives one learner the dedicated attention of a qualified chartered accountant for two full working days. The learner sits at a real desk in a real practice, works on real anonymised client material, and leaves with a certificate, a personal reference letter, signed school work experience forms and printed A4 guides covering everything they learned.

There are no group placements, no shared days, no photocopying. The programme is positioned as professional development and treats every learner as a future colleague.

WHO IT IS FOR

- School students in Year 11, Year 12 or Year 13.
- College and BTEC students from any field of study who are exploring whether accounting or finance is the right direction.
- Learners considering AAT, accounting apprenticeships or finance-related university courses.

WHAT THE LEARNER LEAVES WITH

SAFEGUARDING WRAP

Every mentor working with under-18 learners holds a current enhanced DBS check. LOYALS operates a written safeguarding policy with a named Designated Safeguarding Lead, public and employer's liability insurance endorsed for minors on-site, parental consent forms covering attendance, photography, emergency medical authorisation and data processing, and ICO data protection registration. A first aid trained team member is on-site every programme day. The full safeguarding policy is available as a separate download.

HOW A SCHOOL BOOKS

1. Email the Designated Safeguarding Lead at kris.nick@loyals.uk with the year group, approximate number of learners and preferred dates.
2. LOYALS responds within three working days, confirms availability and shares the parental consent form for the relevant cohort.
3. Once parental consent and invoices are settled, dates are locked and the welcome pack is sent two weeks before the programme.
